Landscaping Works – Jean and John Mulder Park

Dear Resident,

### **Landscaping Works – Jean and John Mulder Park**

The Town would like to advise that the garden beds in the north, south and east of Jean and John Mulder Park are due to be revegetated throughout the month of June 2025 (weather, nursery delivery and contractor availability permitting). There will also be some mulching being undertaken in late May in preparation.

The landscaping project is being funded by the Town as well as the Polyphagous Shot Hole Borer Recovery Grant from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation. When the five Moreton Bay figs were removed due to PSHB, the understorey plant canopy was also destroyed. Local native species have been chosen to restore these areas, similar to those in the bushland at Lake Claremont, with the majority being low growing shrubs, grasses and groundcovers and several shade trees planned.

Flat turf areas in the south-western corner of the park will be retained for family gathering spaces. A walkway, with no plantings will be left in the centre of the southern planting area to ensure connectivity between the playground and BBQ area is continued. Irrigation modifications have also been considered to ensure the new plantings receive enough water over the warm summer months for the first two years, as they establish.

Works are expected to occur during working hours, between 7am and 5pm on weekdays. Please keep out of contractor work areas and avoid trampling new plants.

While it is inevitable that works of this nature will cause some inconvenience, every effort will be made to ensure that this is kept to a minimum.
