

Youth Photography Competition 2024 - *What makes you happy*

Overview

The Town of Claremont's 2024 Youth Photography Competition 'What makes you happy' is open to all young people aged between 12-18 years who reside in and/or go to school in the following local government boundaries: Town of Cambridge, Town of Claremont, Town of Cottesloe, Town of Mosman Park, City of Nedlands, Shire of Peppermint Grove, and City of Subiaco.

The Town is keen to see 'what makes you happy', caught in your own creative way, on camera. The judges will be looking for:

- Originality
- Image quality (*note: when taking photographs on your mobile phone, ensure it is on the highest resolution setting. Submissions must be a minimum of 300dpi.*)
- Happiness

Entries open on from 9am Friday 5 April 2024 to celebrate WA Youth Week. Entries close on 5pm Monday 20 May 2024.

Terms and Conditions of Entry Youth Photography Competition 2024

By submitting an entry for the 2024 Youth Photography Competition, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Entrants must be between 12-18 years and reside in and/or go to school in the following local government boundaries:
 - Town of Cambridge,
 - Town of Claremont,
 - Town of Cottesloe,
 - Town of Mosman Park,
 - City of Nedlands,
 - Shire of Peppermint Grove, and
 - City of Subiaco
2. Entrants may only submit one (1) photograph, which must be submitted via the online form on the Town of Claremont website.
3. Entries must be the original work of the entrant and taken within the last 6 months.
4. Submissions must be a minimum of 300dpi.
5. Only entries received by 5pm Monday 20 May 2024 will be accepted.
6. No images of people can be accepted without proof of written permission from that person. Permission must be available upon request by the Town.
7. The Town will not be held liable for any damage, loss (both direct and indirect) and/or injury sustained by an entrant during photographing or participation in this competition, whilst exhibited or otherwise. You participate in the competition at your own risk.
8. The winning cash prizes are not negotiable, transferable, or exchangeable.
9. The photography workshop will be offered to the 24 shortlisted entrants. The date and time of the workshop is not transferrable.
10. All entrants consent to the Town retaining the photographic image for use in future publications (website/social media/print collateral etc).
11. All entrants (24) who are shortlisted must consent to being in a photograph for advertising, marketing or promotional purposes including print and electronic media for the Town.

12. The judging panel's decision is final. No disputes will be entered into.
13. The Town reserves the right at its sole discretion to remove and/or disqualify any entries that breach these terms and conditions and/or are deemed to be inappropriate and/or offensive including photos racial or political messages.
