Perth Caravan and Camping Show - 20 to 23 March

The Perth Caravan and Camping Show will be held at the Claremont Showgrounds from 20 to 23 March 2025. To minimise disruptions and ensure public safety, the Town will implement temporary parking control measures during the event.

Temporary Parking Restrictions

Temporary parking restrictions will be in place on several streets surrounding the Claremont Showgrounds. The Community Safety team will patrol these areas to ensure compliance. Please refer to the attached map for details. Vehicles parked contrary to signage will be infringed.

No-Stopping Zones

- No-Stopping Road Graylands Road, First Avenue, Second Avenue, Mengler Avenue, Mofflin Avenue and Stubbs Terrace.
- No-Stopping Road or Verge Graylands Road, Ashton Avenue and Brockway Road

Precinct & Resident Parking

- Existing timed parking restrictions will remain in place. Residents with valid parking permits must ensure they are displayed.
- The Town will not issue temporary parking permits. If restrictions apply to verge parking in your area, alternative arrangements must be made to avoid infringements.

Management of Street Verges

Residents may allow others to park on their verges but must ensure vehicles are parked safely and do not obstruct footpaths or driveways. Vehicles parked in an unsafe manner may be infringed.
